Exceptional property of 4 hectares designed by the architect Robert Streitz for Mademoiselle Chanel and the Duke of Westminster. Mademoiselle Chanel was actively involved in all stages of the design and creation of the property, which was her French Riviera residence from 1929 to 1953.

The estate has a long and wonderfully colourful history involving artists, musicians, writers and painters, including Stravinsky, Cocteau, Picasso, Bonnard, Luchino Visconti, Somerset Maugham. It was later inhabited by author, literary agent and art collector Emery Reves: during that time, Winston Churchill was a frequent guest. But the villa was also a social destination for such other figures as Field Marshal Bernard Montgomery, the Duke of Windsor, Noel Coward, Aristotle Onassis, Greta Garbo, Rose Kennedy, as well as Graham Sutherland, Prince Rainier and Princess Grace, Konrad Adenauer, Anthony Eden, and Paul Reynaud.
